

## Water Scarcity Solution

Water scarcity is an issue that is threatening millions of people across the world. In the near future, we may see that people might not have access to clean water. Saudi Arabia is one of the countries that is facing such troubles and it needs an instant solution. I suggest first to educate people and teach them about the problem because not everyone is aware that such a problem exists. Moreover, since most of the water is wasted for unnecessary reasons, decision makers must check the average water consumption per person per day and assign it to households accordingly. If the limit is exceeded, additional charges would have to be paid. So, for example, if the average water consumption per person is 200 liters and a family consists of 5 members, this household can use up to 1,000 liters per day at regular cost. If they exceed 1,000 liters, they would have to pay an additional charge for each liter used. This solution will force family members to adopt various techniques to reduce their water usage; such as using water-saving shower heads and simply taking shorter showers or turning off the tap while brushing their teeth. These simple changes will lead to the more rationalized use of water.
